RESPONSIBILITIES

- Install, maintain, and repair pumps, motors, electrical/mechanical controls, valves & pipes
- Maintain and repair sewer lift stations, booster stations, pumping stations
- Operate a variety of small equipment (forklift, boom truck)
- Inspect and test tools, vehicles, and safety gear
- Review and restock supplies, perform service vehicle inventory
- Monitor and ensure proper environmental and safety conditions
- Function on a rotating "on call" basis for wastewater emergencies

- Perform basic math calculations
